### **The swarm response service:**

The HWBKA provides an ‘advice and swarm collection’ service to members of the public in our locality, if they experience difficulties caused by bees or are visited by an unwanted swarm. Practical help is often necessary in such circumstances and is provided whenever possible. We have a 24 hour Helpline and can be contacted on **07527 798659**.

The service is operated by Association members on a voluntary basis. Our advice and/or help service is offered in good faith, but without liability or guarantee of success; there are limits to what we can reasonably achieve!
