Bee Disease Insurance (BDI)

Bee Diseases Insurance Ltd. is set up and run by beekeepers for beekeepers, owned by Member Beekeeping Associations and offers some financial compensation for the replacement cost of any hive parts that need to be destroyed following the discovery of a notifiable disease. All members of HWBKA are members and the minimum £2 premium is included in Individual and Family Membership subscriptions.

It is important to pay additional premiums as necessary to insure **all hives containing bees** regardless of size of the colony **and allowing for increase** through the season .
